Article I (1)	Created the Legislative Branch (Congress)
Article II (2)	Created the Executive Branch (President)
Article III (3)	Created the Judicial Branch (Courts)
Article IV (4)	Article that tells how the states work with each other. For example how states must recognize things like marriages from other states. It also talks about how we add more states.
Article V (5)	Article that tells us how it gets amended (changed)

Article VI (6)

States that the Constitution is the supreme law of the land

Article VII (7)

Article that addresses ratification (approval) and declares that the constitution should take affect if 9 out of 13 states ratify (approve).
