

# TLO vs New Jersey

Right to Privacy in Schools, 4th Amendment

Landmark US Supreme Court case that determines what schools can & cannot do when searching students in school.

Court ruled that schools can search students if they have reasonable suspicion. No blanket searches are allowed.

# 4th Amendment

Guarantees a right to privacy and protection from illegal searches. In schools, students can be searched by school officials if they have a "reasonable suspicion" that they will find something.
